EXECUTIVE MBA:

Northeastern's Executive MBA (EMBA) is a 16-month, globally-focused program for seasoned professionals ready to advance to the next level of leadership. The EMBA program provides direct exposure to international and intercultural business dynamics, enabling you to compete effectively in the global marketplace. Students can continue working full-time during the program and are part of a cohort, attending class on alternating Fridays and Saturdays. The program begins in January.



HIGH TECH MBA:

Northeastern's High Tech MBA is a 21-month, accelerated program for technology-savvy professionals who want to drive business innovation. The High Tech MBA program emphasizes management and leadership skills, designed to help you fuel enterprise growth and rapidly advance in technology-intensive environments. Students can continue working full-time during the program and are part of a cohort, attending class every other week on Tuesday evenings and Saturdays. The program begins in September.



EVENING MBA:

Northeastern's Evening MBA is a flexible, part-time program that gives you the freedom to complete your degree on your own timetable. The program can be completed in as little as two or as long as seven years. Students may attend classes at Northeastern's main campus or our campus in Boston's financial district. Parking is available, and both campuses are also accessible via MBTA lines. Classes begin in January and September.

EXPERIENCE INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS.

Northeastern's EMBA program stands out by making international residencies a fully integrated component of a rigorous global business curriculum. Business issues explored in the classroom are reinforced through real-world learning experiences. Residencies are brief (ranging from three to twelve days) to accommodate the schedules of busy working professionals.

This year's EMBA students will visit companies in Hong Kong and China where they will meet with C-level executives to learn about their business models, organizational structures, key challenges, and growth strategies. Students will also study in Washington, D.C. to explore the dynamics of business and government, as well as in Mexico City at IPADE Business School to experience cross-cultural business issues. EMBA students can see first-hand how other countries and other cultures do business, gain international business savvy, and learn to compete effectively in the global marketplace.

LEARN AMONG LEADERS.

The EMBA program is designed for individuals who have reached a senior level in their careers, with an average of 10–15 years of experience. EMBA students learn in a cohort, attending the same courses with the same classmates throughout the program. The result is a strong network of seasoned professionals who can contribute rich insights to group projects and class discussions.

A typical EMBA class might include directors of sales, vice presidents of finance, operations managers, directors of marketing, and entrepreneurs who run their own companies. You will have the opportunity to see different perspectives and learn about diverse organizational dynamics from your peers who are also actively working in strategic senior management roles.

EXPAND YOUR GLOBAL NETWORK.

As an EMBA student, you have the benefit of working in partnership with a strong network of accomplished faculty, alumni mentors, and executives at leading companies. Residencies allow you to meet with business leaders and collaborate with other MBA students from around the world. You can also interact with executives at Fortune 500 companies who participate in EMBA classes to share their insights on emerging trends and exemplary business practices.

The lessons learned during your Executive MBA program—from your classmates, faculty, alumni, executive guest speakers, and international residencies—can help you refine your leadership skills and reach the next level of success in your career.
